Know where you can camp on public lands and check for restrictions or closures.



Watch the weather. Avoid campfires on hot, dry and windy days. Check local fire danger and red flag warnings.

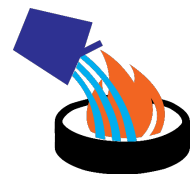
Be ready to put out a fire. Pack a fire extinguisher, water and a shovel.



Do not drive, idle or park on tall, dry grass. Only drive or park in areas clear of flammable materials, such as grass and shrubs.



Make sure your fire is dead out. Never leave a fire unattended. Drown, stir, drown again and check for warmth.
