Building tourism in a manageable, sustainable way can stimulate and diversify the local economy, protect and enhance local resources and foster community pride without compromising the qualities that make the community so special. The PCTGP aims to elevate communities across the state, increase their economic vibrancy by improving their appeal as visitor destinations, and to improve their resilience as a destination through enhancing and diversifying tourism related assets and infrastructure.
